2008-2009 School Profile

SCHOOL:

Summit Christian Academy (SCA) comprises a non-denominational, independent school system, operating on two campuses, offering grades Pre-K through 12 to the greater Northwest Austin Texas community. As a college and life preparatory, co-educational school that began operations in 2003, SCA also features character development rooted in traditional values and a strong emphasis on service to the community. SCA is fully accredited through the Association of Christian Schools

ADMISSION GUIDELINES:

Summit Christian Academy offers a program for students who desire an excellent education in a Christian environment. An interview for all new students is required for admission. SCA evaluates student candidates based on their character, academic record, and behavioral background. SCA evaluates applicants academically by reviewing a student's most recent report card, his/her academic transcripts, and his/her current scores within the previous academic year from a nationally normed achievement test and an aptitude test. Students entering 1st through 12 grades must provide these items.

FACULTY:

44 full-time faculty; 4 part time faculty

ACADEMIC CALENDAR:

SCA operates 174 full days from August through May

STUDENT BODY:

The total enrollment in 2008-2009 is 424. Elementary (PK-6) enrollment is 286, Middle School (7-8) enrollment is 65, and High School (9-12) enrollment is 72. Seventeen students comprise the Class of 2009.

CLASS RANK:

SCA ranks as follows: Top 10%, the first quartile is comprised of students with cumulative averages greater than 89.4, the 2nd quartile is comprised of students with cumulative averages greater than 84.4, the 3rd quartile is comprised of students with cumulative averages greater than 79.4. SCA uses a graduated 4.0 grading scale. Our school also offers honors, pre-advanced placement and dual credit classes, which are based on a 5.0 scale as well as advanced placement classes which are based on a 6.0 scale. The Valedictorian and Salutatorian must have attended SCA their last four semesters, and they must maintain the highest two grade point averages (GPA's).
