A glimpse into the classroom..

Here is an overview of what Impact Education looks like at the elementary level...

Kindergarten students learn that prayer is the foundation of all ministry. Through games and activities, students learn that prayer is both powerful and fun! Kindergartners also learn about Christian heroes they can look up to.

First and second graders make pretend passports to "travel" to global destinations! They learn about world cultures, religious beliefs, and a personal story of a child from each country. First and second graders learn that God created all people groups and He loves each and every one of them.

Third graders learn about the largest unreached people group in the world—the people living in the 10/40 Window.

Through games and activities, they will learn about the important aspects of the religions and cultures of these people. Third graders learn how to pray effectively for the people and missionaries in the 10/40 Window.

Fourth graders focus on the history and cultures of the First Nations People. They will learn about the atrocities committed against these people and how to effectively pray for them. Fifth graders learn about the persecuted church around the world today. Through stories, activities, skits, and videos, students will become familiar with what life is like for members of the persecuted church. Students learn how to pray and reach out to the persecuted church.

Sixth graders learn how to put together a chapel service in order to serve others. Students are empowered with the realization that they can work together and use their gifts and talents to serve and lead.
