Tuition Payments

It is hard to believe that the second tuition payment (September) is due next week. Account balances are to be paid on the 1st of each month and payment will be considered late after the close of business on the 5th. At that time a \$25 late payment fee will be charged to the account. SCA does not send out monthly statements since you may access your account through RenWeb at any time. We are also sad to announce that due to new federal regulations, you may no longer pay your account with a credit card. However, there are still a variety of payment options. You may bring your payment to the office, set us up on bill pay with your bank, have SCA automatically withdraw it from your bank, or do an e-check through RenWeb. The e-check through RenWeb has an \$0.85 fee for each transaction and it is posted to your account immediately.
